Briefly summarize how your attendance at the conference enhanced your professional development and allowed you to gain a better understanding of teaching in your discipline or trends in higher education in general.

Attendance at ALTA46's panel on building an undergraduate translation curriculum greatly enhanced my professional development by supporting the presentation of curricular goals and degree pathway summaries for the new BA in Translation, for which I am the Director. I was able to share data regarding enrollment trends, the incorporation of various GE courses into our foundations curriculum, study abroad/internship/community engagement opportunities, and the overall learning outcomes of translation for global literacy. This showcase was important because UI's program is the first of its kind in the country, and thus a blueprint program for faculty who are interested in starting similar programs at other institutions.

How have you been able to share what you learned about teaching with your department, the University of Iowa, and/or beyond?

Post-conference, I have maintained connections with faculty at other institutions. I will be presenting a half-day session on syllabi and assignment design and scaffolding in undergraduate translation curriculum at the joint Center for Translation and Global Literacy/American Translating and Interpreting Studies Association summer institute, June 5-9, 2024 hosted at the University of Iowa, where faculty from institutions across the country will be gathering to learn about the BA in Translation at Iowa and how to implement related courses, certificates, and programs at their own institutions.
